



ForestBank



DESCRIPTION

ForestBankTM, a new type of engineered wood made from forest debris. To create this material, leaves, bark, seeds, soil and other items are mixed with a reactive mineral base and a water-based acrylic resin that does not contain organic solvents or volatile organic compounds. The resulting material offers unique patterns that vary depending on the season and conditions of the forest when harvesting.

A chair made of high-quality Japanese Hinoki wood from sustainable forests from the Higashishirakawa-area and made manually by local artisans. Stool is designed for longevity and assembled by simple joints.







Rattan Stool



DESCRIPTION

Rattan is a material that usually is associated with baskets or rattan furniture for which it is commonly used. In this project rattan was used for the same purpose - creating a stool, but rather in an unusual way in comparison to regular weaving techniques. It is sustainable and durable and is an exceptional wood that renews itself in only 5-7 years. Designers love rattan for creating furniture because the production is low-tech, and the manufacturing process usually involves handcrafting or using structures that do not have a negative impact on the environment.






